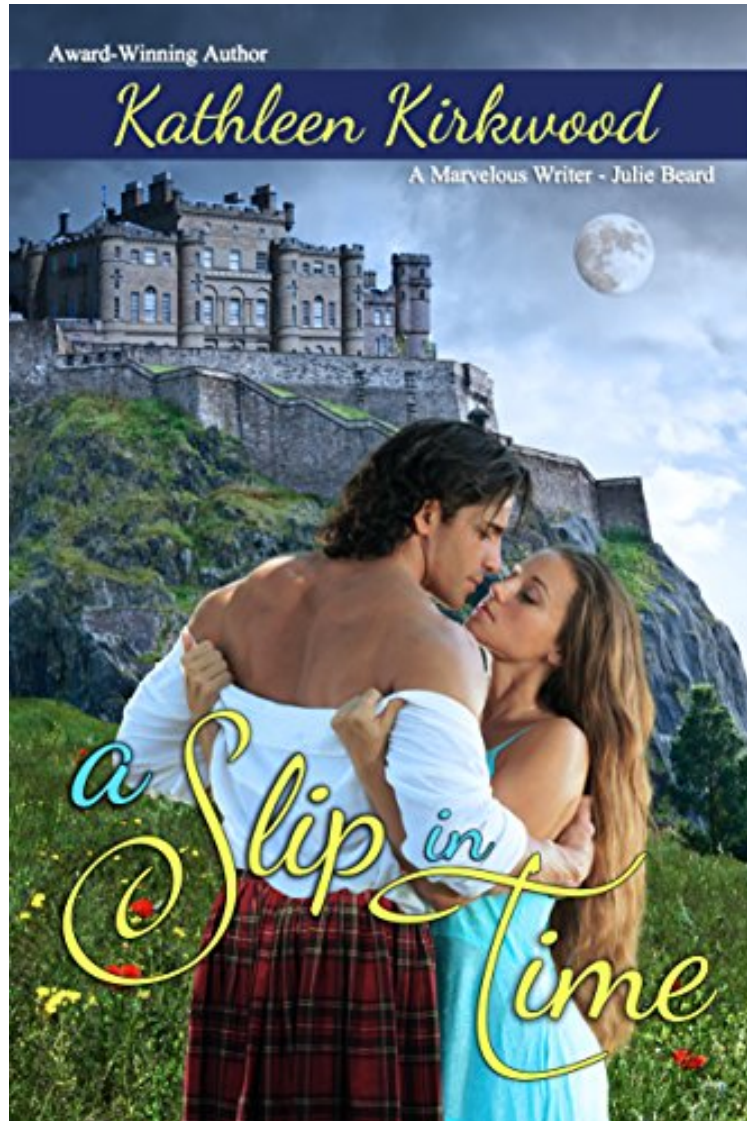

Sie liegt abends im Bett, als sie pltzlich von dem sprlich bekleideten Highlander McKinnan, 29 Jahre, aus dem Zimmer getragen und vor die Tr geworfen wird, weil dieser sie schlafend in ihrem Bett vorfindet. Sie irrt durch die Schlognge und erkennt, dass die Leute, die sie sehen kann, nicht aus ihrer Zeit sind. Immer nachts und nur in ihrem Turmzimmer

wird ihr Schlaf von diesen Erscheinungen unterbrochen. Sie findet sich dann plötzlich ins Jahr 1450 zurückversetzt. Auf diesen Moment hatte der Lord von Dunraven 20 Jahre lang gewartet. Denn auch er war einmal Zeuge eines solchen TimeSlips. Zusammen mit Julia und seinen befreundeten, alten Wissenschaftlern versuchen sie nun mit primitiven Megerten das Zeitphänomen zu erforschen und treffen sich fter nachts in Julias Zimmer um Messungen zu machen. Dabei kommen sich Julia und McKinnan immer nher und verlieben sich unsterblich. Doch Julias verwante Cousine und Roger Dunnington, Erbe des Lord von Dunraven, verfolgen beide ihre eigenen Ziele. Sie ziehen falsche Schlüsse aus den heimlichen, nichtlichen Treffen und spinnen ihre Intrigen. Auch in McKinnans Zeit gibt es Auseinandersetzungen um vermeintliche Viehdiebe und die Thronfolge. In beiden Zeiten spitzt sich die Lage zu. Bis der Leser mit leidenschaftlichen Liebeszenen und einem wohlverdienten, sen HappyEnd belohnt wird. Die ersten dreißig Prozent der Geschichte fingen recht langsam an, aber danach stieg die Spannung stetig und ich konnte das Buch nicht mehr aus der Hand legen.
