Dieser Teil ist gut und logisch, auch wenn es manchmal zu einfach scheint, wie der Traveler aus der einen Situation mühelos entkommt und den Tag rettet und es andererseits unnötige "Reckenschläge" für die Crew gibt, bei denen der Traveler eben nichts gemacht hat, obwohl er meiner Meinung nach könnte. Die zweite Storyline umfasst Picard und die inneren Zweifel des Captains sind glaubwürdig dargestellt. Seine Befragung und die Unterstellung unter psychische Bevormundung erscheinen mir aber irgendwie albern und des Characters nicht würdig. This book feels blown way out of proportion and is filled with useless story arcs that lead nowhere. Our characters mainly rush from A to B, do this and that, but don't really accomplish anything. Even the stunning surroundings start to get boring after a while, which really is a shame. Also the language and characterizations are deteriorating from the first book, as if the author wrote this one in a rush. Wesley's love story for example seems more like an afterthought: "Let's put some more stuff in this book, we need it to be 296 pages long." Sad to say it, but this book left me unsatisfied.
