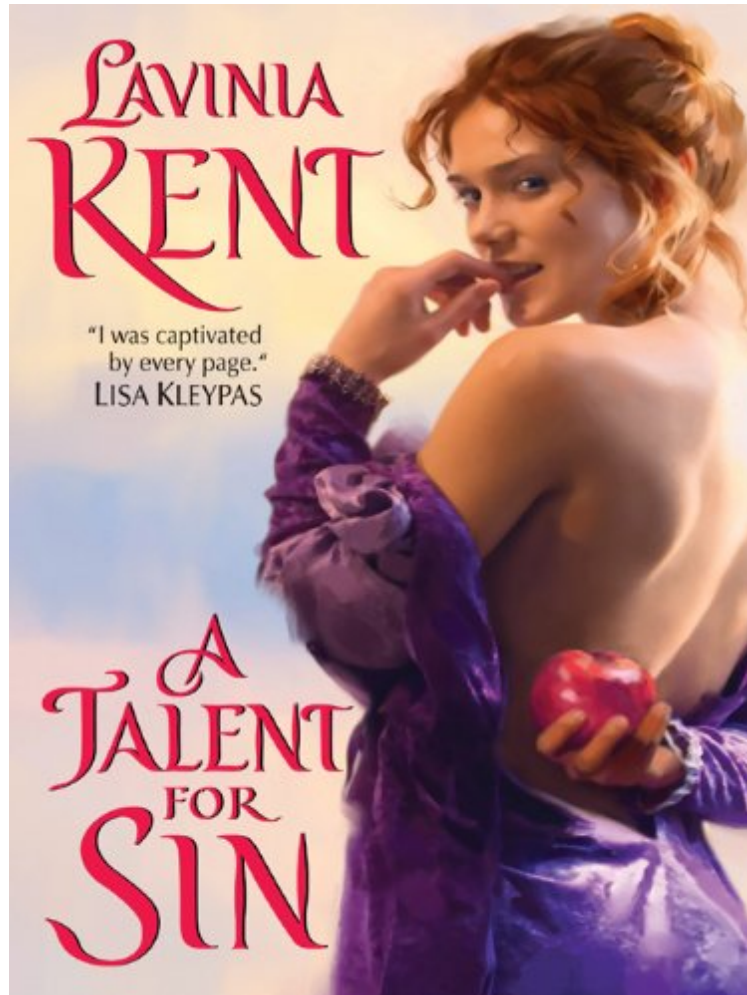

Certainly 'A Talent For Sin' felt very unusual.Not that Violet, Lady Carrington, is THAT old - she's thirty one. And Peter's twenty six, so not exactly a schoolboy. However Violet has also been married and widowed three times, each time to much older men, and has decided that she wants to remain unmarried for the rest of her life - it means she has control over her life and isn't at the mercy of any men.The book starts with the relationship between Violet and Peter. They are lovers but Peter wants more. Violet refuses. Peter tries to seduce her into marriage, Violet refuses. It's a bit back-and-forth at the beginning but the story

soon widens as we meet Violet's much younger sister and discover that she may be married off to a very unpleasant older man. Violet steps in to help, Peter also tries his best, and it looks as if they will never find happiness. But of course this is a romance, we know things will work out - and they do. There was one scene, when Violet agrees to seduce the man who wants to marry her sister, that was almost impossible to read. Not because of the sex - there's a fair amount of this throughout the book - but because you know it's such a horrendous experience for her. I felt the end of the book was a bit rushed and that Violet and Peter's misunderstandings felt contrived, but overall I felt it was well written and it was interesting to read a story where the heroine is the older person in the relationship.
