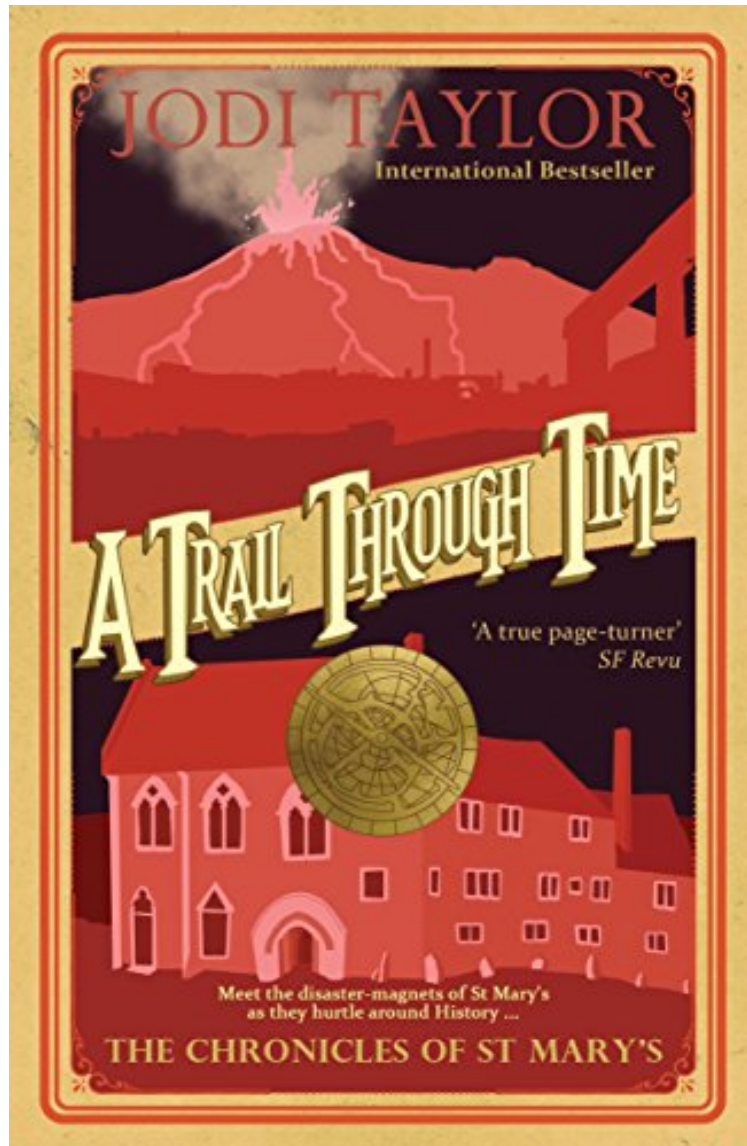

So, you are already hooked and will get this one, too. SLIGHT SPOILER! I'm trying not to give away too many details, only the impression of the book. As I started reading, my first impression was "Oh great, Jodi Taylor took to a parallel universe plot". More often than not, this means to me, the author has trouble fitting the plot together (remember LOST?). Yet, since the writing is great, I pushed away physical and philosophical doubts (the setting is about time-travel which we also deem impossible but too fascinating to ignore). To my big surprise, Jodi Taylor created one of the rare exceptions to the above rule. This is one of the rare occasions, where the parallel universe is not a patch on the plot line. Max is hurled into a parallel world, where she can no longer rely on her own, old experience. She has to figure out, what truths still apply and whom to trust. The fourth installment of the St. Mary's series is slightly darker than the first books and at first I found it hard to get used to the known characters being rather different in how they interact with Max. We learn a bit more about Max' childhood which is just really sad. However the speed of the story won't allow you to dwell and soon we find our beloved historians, technicians and other St. Mary's friends fighting their biggest battle yet. New enemies are on the scene and old enemies we happily thought dead are back and just as evil as ever. Als erstes bin ich nicht ein Fan von Paralleluniversen, was hier aber der Fall ist. Ich fand es irritierend, auch wenn ich es aus der Sicht der Autorin nachvollziehen kann. Sie will natürlich die Beziehung zwischen den zwei Hauptcharakteren nicht aufgeben, für mich war es aber nicht wirklich sinnvoll eingebettet und ich konnte mich damit nur mäßig anfreunden. Das wäre im Endeffekt nicht das größte Problem, wenn nicht noch die anderen Sachen dazu kämen. Zweitens fand ich die Ausflüge in die Geschichte für mich nur sehr kurz, vor allem im Vergleich mit den anderen Büchern. Natürlich ist es aus der Sicht der Geschichte schon sinnvoll so, aber für mich hat die Serie vor allem den Reiz darin gehabt, sich mit den verschiedenen Epochen auseinander zu setzen. Das kam mir hier im Allgemeinen kürzer vor, als in den anderen Teilen. Drittens fand ich die Bedrohung für St. Mary's aufgesetzt. Gerade im letzten Teil sind sie einen Besseren losgeworden, und jetzt ist da jemand neues. Gut, im Paralleluniversum denkbar, für mich aber zu viel unnötige Aktion. Ich hoffe immer noch auf den nächsten Teil, so dass eine meiner Lieblingsserien nicht zur Enttäuschung wird.
