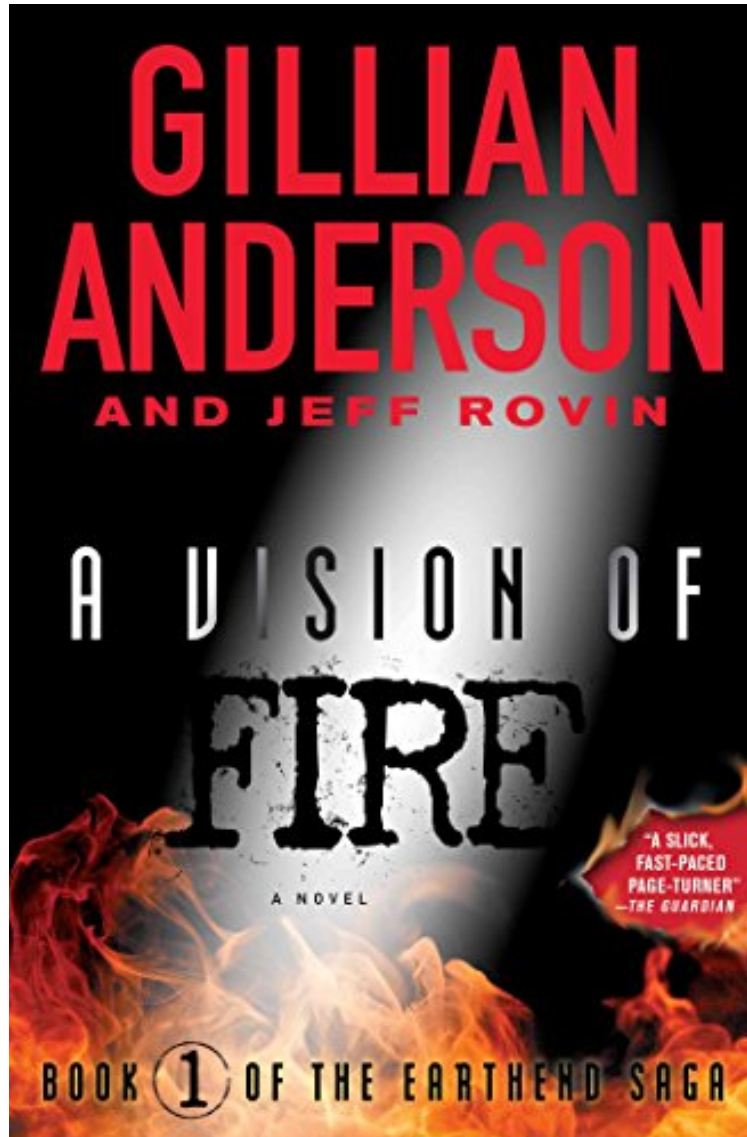

Denn egal ob die Mystery-Ikone Anderson literarisch selbst Hand anlegte oder grobteils als Aushängeschild dient, *A Vision of Fire* hat es in sich. Die englischsprachige Presse fand wenig Positives zu rezensieren. Dem kann ich mich nicht anschließen. Hauptfigur ist die Psychiaterin Caitlin O'Hara, eine selbstbewusste Wissenschaftlerin, die immer mehr in den Bann des Transzendenten gezogen wird (Dana Scully lässt grüßen!). In New York, Teheran oder auf Haiti zeigen drei Jugendliche plötzlich merkwürdige Symptome, sprechen in unbekannter Sprache und werden von apokalyptischen Visionen aus Feuer und Flut geplagt. Vögel, Ratten und ein Hund geraten in Panik. Auch Caitlin selbst scheint mit den herkömmlich nicht erklärbaren Phänomenen irgendwie verknüpft zu sein. Zeiten und Ebenen greifen ineinander, und auch im Hier und Jetzt droht zwischen Indien und Pakistan ein atomarer Konflikt. Die Spannung und das damit einhergehende mulmige Gefühl bleiben lange aufrecht. Erst in den letzten Kapiteln erfährt man, was der Auslöser all dessen ist. Als Cliffhanger zum 2.
