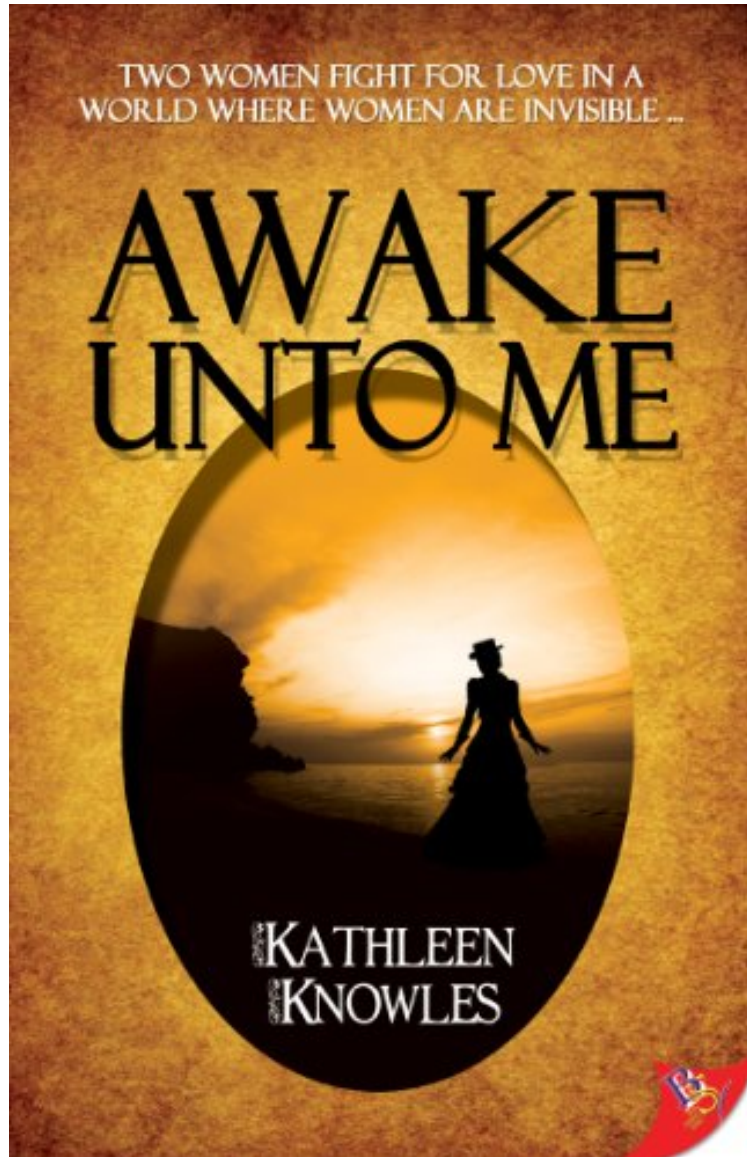

One of the characters is going through sexual

abuse at the hands of an authority figure. The novel has a few editing issues (some head hopping, overuse of adverbs, commas missing, etc.), but it's entertaining and provides some well-researched and well-written historical details.
