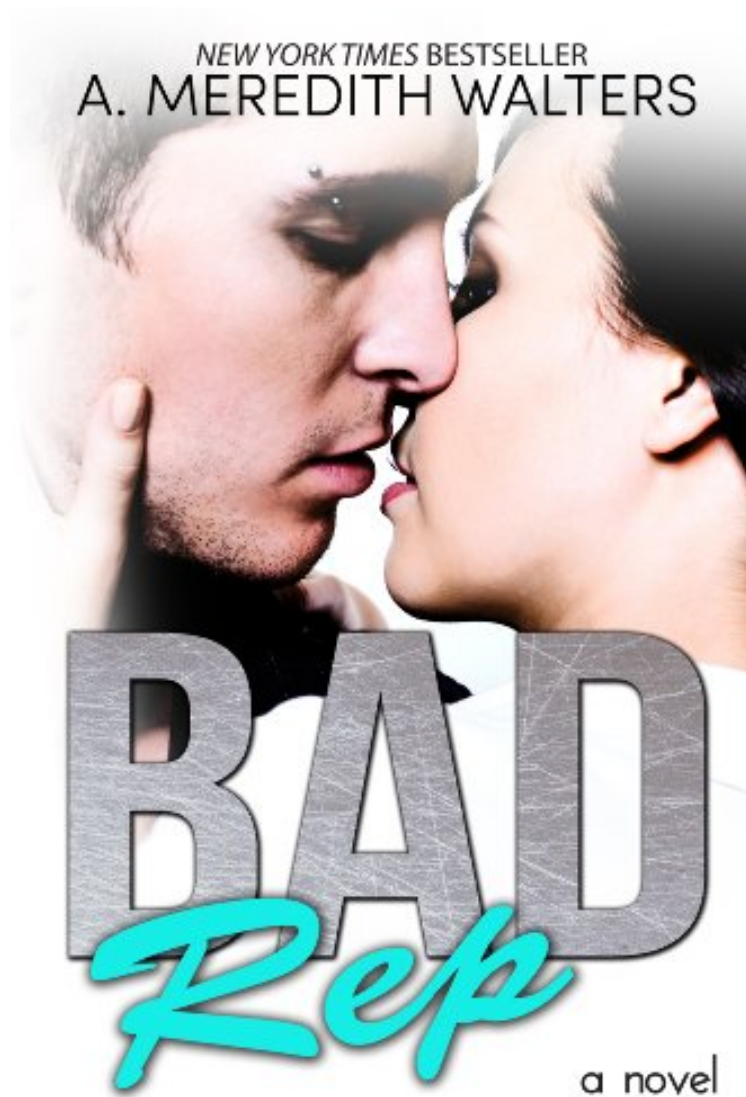

Leider nicht so meins!Das Leben kann so unfair sein! Ich-Erzherlin Maysie Ardin hat den Sommer damit verbracht die Kreditkarte ihrer Eltern

(eigentlich nur im absoluten Notfall zu benutzen), zum Glhen zu bringen. Um ihre Schulden zu tilgen, nimmt sie einen zweiten Nebenjob in einer Bar an und trifft dort auf Jordan Levitt. Beide fhlen sich sofort stark zueinander hingezogen. Versucht Maysie eingangs sich von ihm zu distanzieren, ist er doch mit Olivia der Prsidentin ihrer Studentenverbindung zusammen, werden beide schlielich auf einer Party in flagranti erwischt. Nun geht es immer weiter bergab mit Maysie's Ansehen und ein ganz schlechter Ruf hngt ihr nach. Ist der Ruf erst ruiniert, lebt es sich ganz ungeniert! Genau diese Erkenntnis gilt es in Bad Rep - auf viel zu vielen Seiten - zu erkunden. Mir passiert es selten, dass mich die Hauptprotas irgendwann einfach nur noch nerven! Doch hier war es eindeutig der Fall. Maysie war mir in vielen Belangen einfach zu widersprchlich. Ein Beispiel: sie rgert sich ber Jordan, der sich mit ihr verabredet und ihr vorab seine feste Freundin Olivia verschweigt. Gleichzeitig datet Maysie aber selbst jemanden, obgleich nicht ganz so ernsthaft. Hmmm! Ansonsten hat sie ein gutes Selbstbewusstsein, welches verstndlicherweise infolge einiger Gemeinheiten gegen ihre Person zwischenzeitlich leicht brckelt. Ihre Gedankengnge, die nicht immer nachvollziehbar waren und fr unheimlich viel hin und her sorgen, gingen mir reichlich auf den Keks. Jordan ist der heieste Typ schlecht hin. Er ist gepierct, ttowiert und bermig attraktiv. Neben der Prsidentschaft in seiner Studentenverbindung ist er auerdem Drummer und gelegentlich Snger in einer Band. Er ist mit der schnsten Frau Olivia zusammen und verliebt sich nun Hals ber Kopf in Maysie. Statt fr klare Fronten zu sorgen, geht er erst einmal den bequemen Weg und was folgt ist natrlich eine Katastrophe. Mehr jedoch fr Maysie. Enorm strend: es wird sehr oft erwht wie schn und begabt er ist. Wirklich in allen Lebenslagen: "He's so beautiful". Mit den Liebesbekundungen und stndigen Komplimenten gestaltet es sich hnlich. Es wird dermaen kitschig und stark ausgeschmckt, mein Kindle bentigte ein Auffangbecken. Desweiteren zieht sich die Handlung derart in die Lnge und gefhlt passiert nicht viel. Den Inhalt htte man gut um ein Drittel krzen knnen. Maysie und Jordan haben vor und whrend ihrer Beziehung stndig Up and Down's. Zwar wrde ich beide jetzt nicht als Oberflchlich bezeichnen, aber irgendwie fehlte mir der Zugang. Die Autorin versucht durch elterliche Missverstndnisse und gewollt oberflchlich dargestellte Nebencharaktere, den beiden Tiefgang einzuhauchen. Das wirkt allerdings nur bedingt und ich wurde und wurde nicht warm mit den beiden. Weiterhin ist das Thema Mobbing, und davon muss Maysie so einiges erleben, sehr present. Dennoch ging es mir nicht so nahe. Mir kam es eher so vor, als schauere ich eine Folge 90210. Positiv hingegen empfand ich die Einbindung der Band und deren Auftritte. Ich mag es sehr, wenn Musik in Bchern ein wenig zum Ausdruck kommt. So finden einige Songtexte ihren Platz in der Story. Erwht sei noch, dass es die eine oder andere erotische Szene gibt. Jordan versteht es die Frauen auch mndlich und handwerklich zu begeistern. Ein Naturtalent in jeder Hinsicht! Also ein Buch mehr fr junge Erwachsene. Nun gut. Meinen Geschmack hat A. The writing style is fabulous, the characters are well developed and the story line flows. It is just different from what I expected and so unlike me to like it. But let me explain. I don't like to read books that have cheating in their story line. It usually puts me off of the book. So to have the two main characters do just that should have irritated me to the point where I would have wanted to throw my Kindle against the wall. But it didn't. And this is down to the superb storytelling of A. Meredith Walters. Unlike in other books, the cheaters in this one are dealing with consequences of their actions. Although they start a relationship, it is not flowers and sunshine and birds singing. They are suffering, they feel guilty and tortured and it taints their developing relationship. This is what allowed me to look past the cheating and still want Maysie and Jordan ending up together. I didn't agree with how their relationship began, but the author managed to arouse sympathy in me for the characters. I wanted them to be able to move past it and be happy. Because hell, they truly were made for each other. Jordan was a bad boy on the outside and a sweetheart on the inside. The things he did for Maysie and the things he said to her, made me all gooey. His actions made it so easy to ignore his initial mistakes. But boy, does this guy have jealousy issues. The only thing missing was the chest-beating. Maysie's thoughts and statements were really entertaining. They were written with so much humor and wit that I was laughing out loud to the point I had tears running down my face. And although at times her actions and self-pity drove me insane, it was not unrealistic or uncalled for. The explanations given for her behavior were believable. Besides the great main characters, some of the secondary ones have won my heart also. Riley, Maysie's friend and roommate was a hoot. Opinionated, confident and loyal. I loved her to bits and could relate so much with her snarky attitude. Jordan's friends and band members, especially Cole and Garrett won my heart over. How can you withstand the charismatic Garrett and the slutty Cole?!? And not to forget Eli, Maysie's friend. I liked him from the beginning and I was proven right about my assessment in the end. All in all, I really enjoyed the book. A. Meredith Walters' writing style definitely resonates with me and her story was captivating and engaging. pretty much disappointed in her, and it doesn't matter what she does, she is never good enough. Having that issue Mays tries to fit in her new college life and joins a sorority in order to find new friends and to become popular. Let's just say Maysie tends to let other people dictate her opinion about herself. After a nice shopping trip with some sorority girls Mays spends 3500 on her emergency Visa-card, and that's when "bad stuff" hits the fan- her parents are furious and more disappointed than ever. Mays has to find a second job, to pay off the debt. This leads her and her best friend Riley to a local bar, where her next challenge meets her head on: Jordan Levitt, hot, pierced, tattooed, good-hearted and with a sense of humor. This college guy doesn't only work as a bartender but also plays drums in a local band. There is mutual connection at once. Till one of her sorority sisters points out that Jordan Levitt is not only the president of one of the fraternities but also a very long-termed boyfriend of her own sorority president. Things get really awkward, since the chemistry between the two of them seems to get stronger everyday. I really liked the book. Yes, there was again this insane unexplainable connection at first sight between two main characters, but at the same time the story felt very real.
