Despite all the things he

does, despite his cruelty when he takes Carson hostage, he looks after Carson in a twisted tender way even then. Xavi is not what he seems to start with. Behind that facade of anger, roughness and aggression there is a deeply wounded man, ready to sacrifice himself for those he loves. Still, I'm not sure it is necessary to humiliate Carson to the degree Xavi does, but I do understand what he's trying to achieve. And it works. Carson's character development throughout the book is phenomenal. From hating himself and barely acknowledging what he is, to going out in THAT T-shirt at the end - it did bring a tear to my eye. He shows so much courage and self-acceptance, and such grittiness with his action, my heart was weeping with joy. (Sorry, I usually don't make schmaltzy comments like that, but it totally hits the spot how I felt there) And it is Carson's strength, determination and love that saves his relationship with Xavi in the end. Yes, this book is dark - it has been said in many other reviews, but the message is that we all can be healed, become whole, love and be loved, whatever. It's a message of hope, just like the previous book, *Dangerously Happy*.
