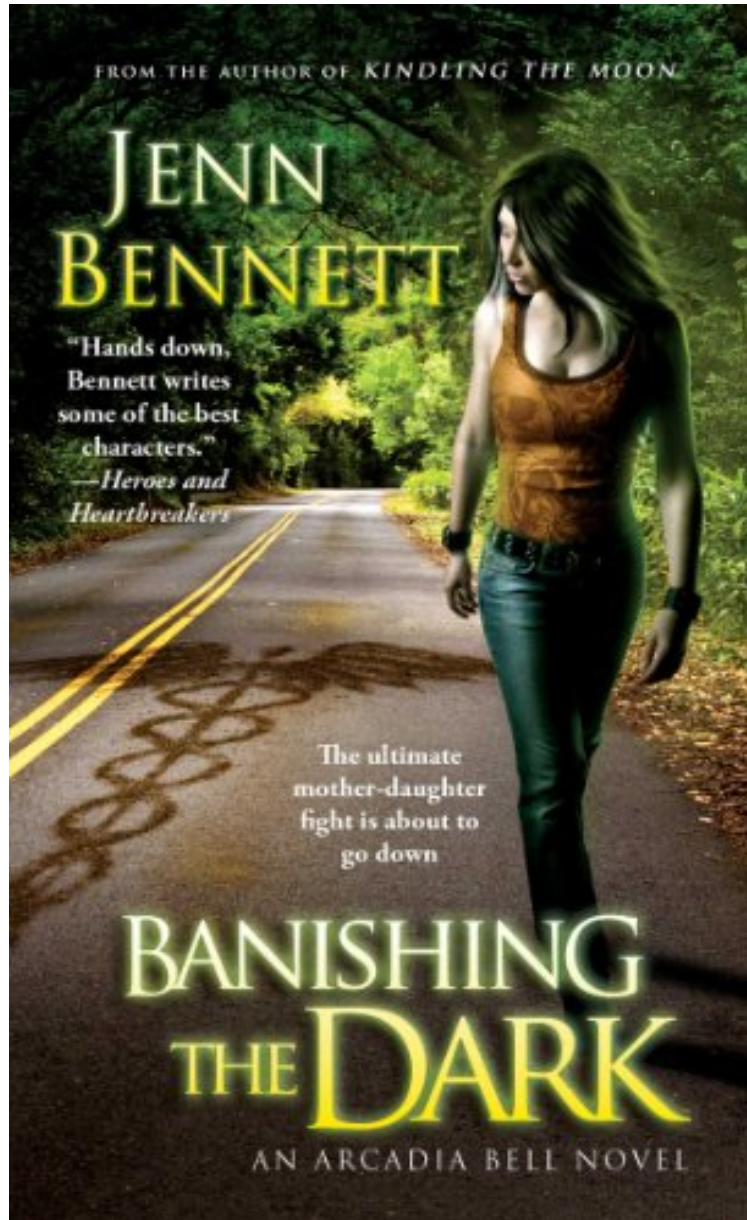

"Arcadia Bell" series. Because of the strong overall story arc, starting the series at this point isn't a good idea. If you're new to the series, I recommend starting with "Kindling the moon." Synopsis Having been injured badly in the last book, Arcadia/Cady slowly comes back to herself - only to discover that her power-hungry mother still haunts the Aether in preparation to come back to earth and take over Cady's body and incredible moonchild-powers. To end that threat once and for all, Cady and Lon must go back to the literal start and find a possibility to unravel the moonchild-spell before crazy Mom achieves her goal and ends Cady and all whom she loves. Review After the "oh kill me now!"-cliffhanger at the end of the last book, I hated Jenn Bennett, decided never to forgive her and threw the book through the room. Now I'm truly happy to announce that I did forgive Miss Bennett, because the last part of Cady, Lon and Jupe's adventures reconciled me with all. It's all I wanted: suspense and the still palpable threat hanging over all of them since the last installment. It's still masterfully done and yet wonderfully counterbalanced by the "Bell-Butler"-family interaction. The love between the three of them can be felt and Jupe is the only teenage son, I like reading about in an UF. Actually, he lights the whole scene whenever he appears or a chapter is told from his POV [interchanging with Cady's POV]. Sometimes he practically outshines the other characters - which is a feat in itself, because as a couple, Lon and Cady are pure awesomeness. But it's not just the characters and the worldbuilding that maintained their high level. The search and at times, the hunt, for the original moonchild spell are nervewracking in a good way, with a fabulous, if short, showdown. The four stars instead of five for the end of the cool series are due to the way a "last obstacle" for Lon and Cady's relationship occurs that felt contrived. Yes, it's well explained, but made me roll my eyes nevertheless. But then, that is my very personal and minor complaint, so to sum it up: the end of the series is well-written, entertaining and totally fits the previous story arc.
