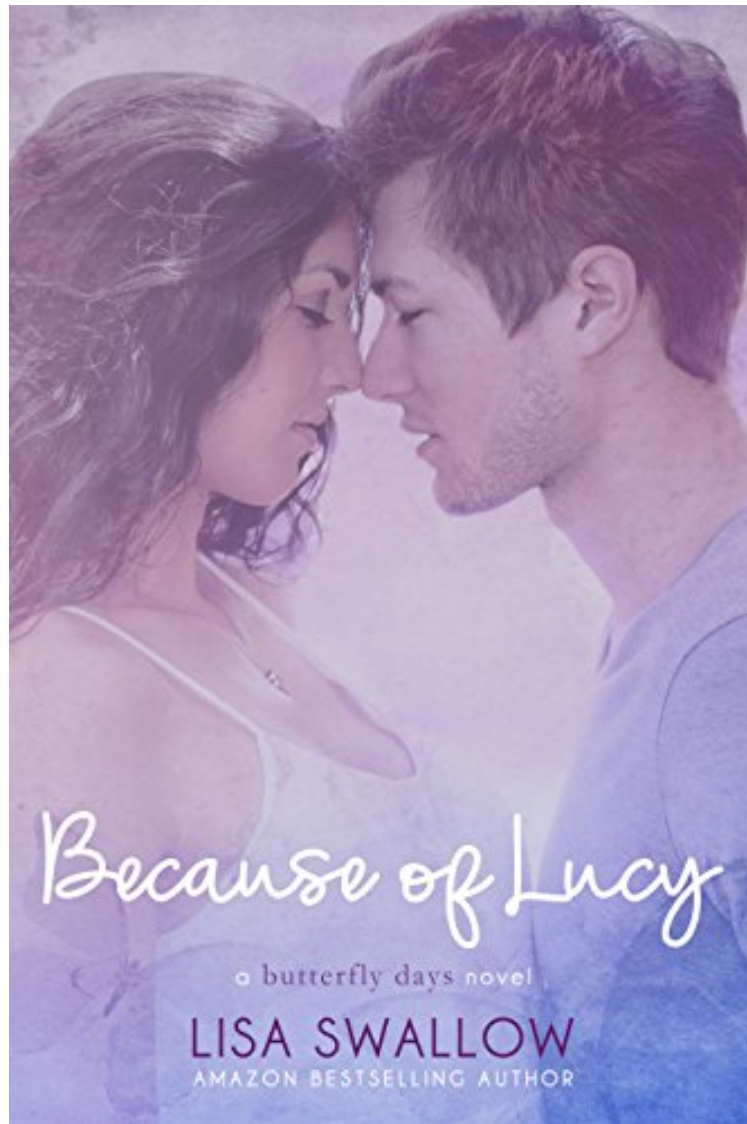

Instead of going to college to be a doctor she moves to the college town with her friend and takes a horrible job at a call center. She is not very happy, doesn't really have any friends, just keeps herself removed from everyone. I am not really sure why she did this, why she couldn't try and be friends with her coworkers or the college kids, but she is not comfortable around any of them since she is not part of their world. She definitely has some issues that she needs to work through, some things to work on, and she needs to figure out what she is really going to do with the rest of her life. Evan is running from his past as well. He has had more responsibility that a teenager should have. He has run away from everything, away from Lucy and everything associated with her, and wants to start a new life. He wants to be free and not tied down. He has quite the reputation for a ladies man, he drinks a lot, he just is trying to have a little freedom after years of responsibility. When Evan and Ness meet one night Evan definitely does not come across as someone Ness should ever be interested in. He is drunk and insults her then doesn't even remember it in the morning. She knows she should stay away, she is a bit insecure when it comes to guys and doesn't want to be used again. Only she keeps getting thrown in situations with him and she finds that he might not be all that she first assumed. She might have had him wrong.
