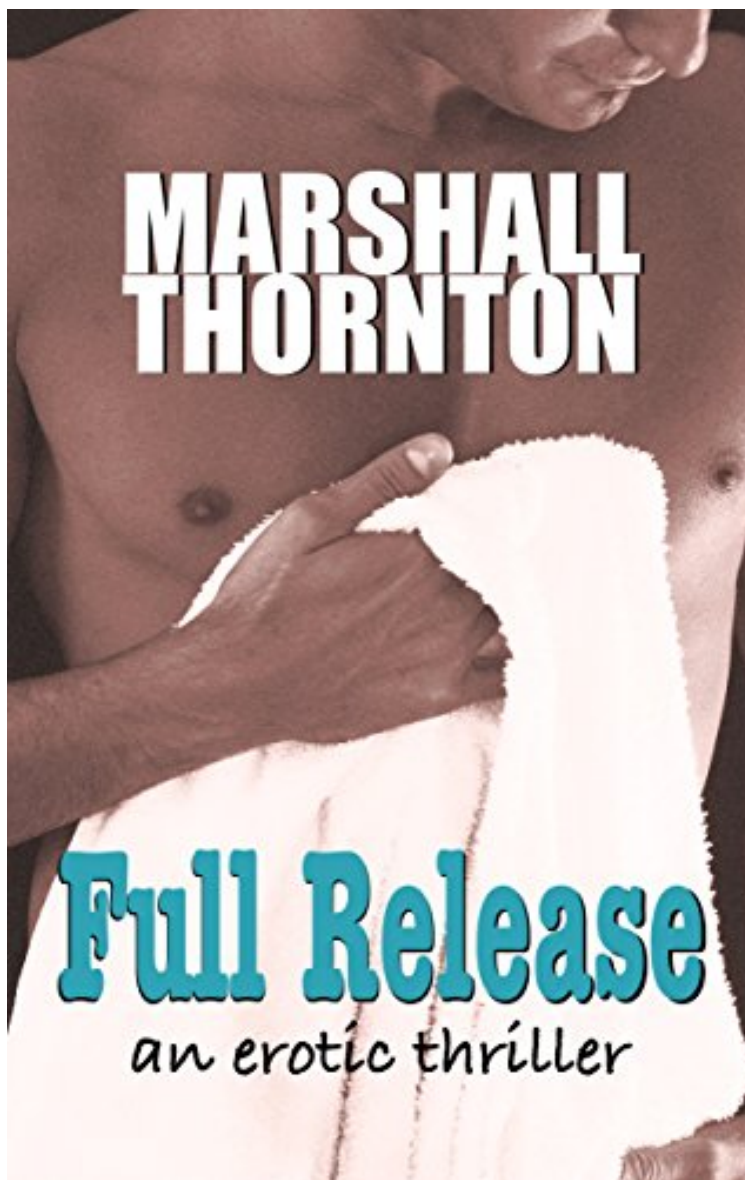

Und da die Handlung sich in diesem Milieu abspielt, hat der Autor recht häufig die Möglichkeit diese Art von "Massagen" zu beschreiben, was er recht anregend tut. Really good Von Querleser Matt is a nice guy - but when his life turns upside-down he is rather helpless. While he often knows what he should or shouldn't do or say and sometimes even wants to do the right (and sensible) thing - more often he fails. The threatening chaos is no surprise and even screaming at protagonist Matt won't help: the reader just has to follow him during his adventures. Authentic characters, nice dialogues, a wicked sense of humour are enough to make this novel a good read, even if it is neither a surprise who the culprit is nor that there is a happy end. It is rather adventurous to accompany Matt for the few weeks he tries to prove that he isn't a murderer. The sex scenes weren't my taste - but to each their own. It was no problem to skip them and as the book is labeled as erotic novel, I can't really complain about it. And it is rather nice, that the massage scenes are part of the plot and not people just having randomly sex all the time. Only the short scene with neighbour Simon is more likely to present Matt as a stupid idiot. And Jeremy's schemes are a bit exaggerated. But all in all I enjoyed this novel. It is rather refreshing that no (good) character is perfect and everyone act stupid at times. Sounds human.
