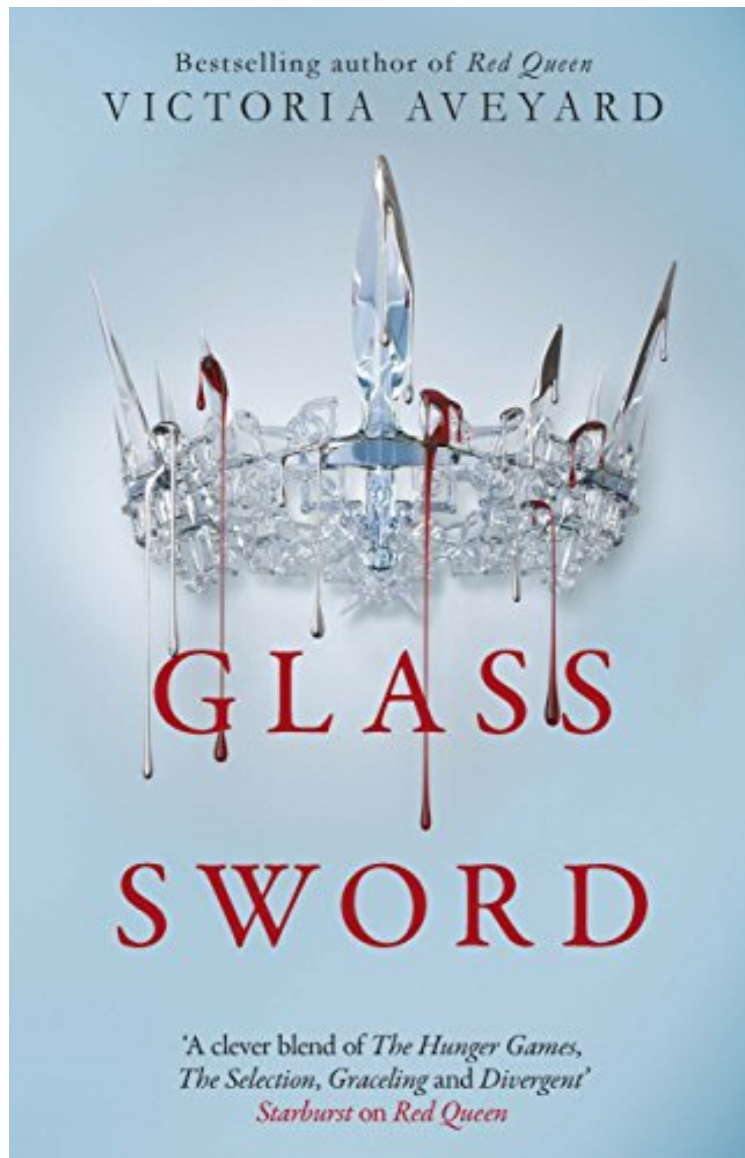

Ich finde es ist ein echter Hingucker und wirklich wunderschön! Perfekt! Nun zum Inhalt selber. Ich kann nur eins sagen: WOW. Mich hat das Buch echt mitgenommen. Das Ende!! Die Welt ist nicht mehr die, die man aus dem 1. Band kennt. Die Scarlet Guard macht sich auf die Suche nach den anderen Menschen, welche rotes Blut aber silberne Fähigkeiten haben und müssen selber aufpassen, nicht in Mares Hände zu geraten. Denn Cal und Mare werden überall gesucht. Gleichzeitig müssen sie aber auch herausfinden, wer sie in dem Ganzen sind.
