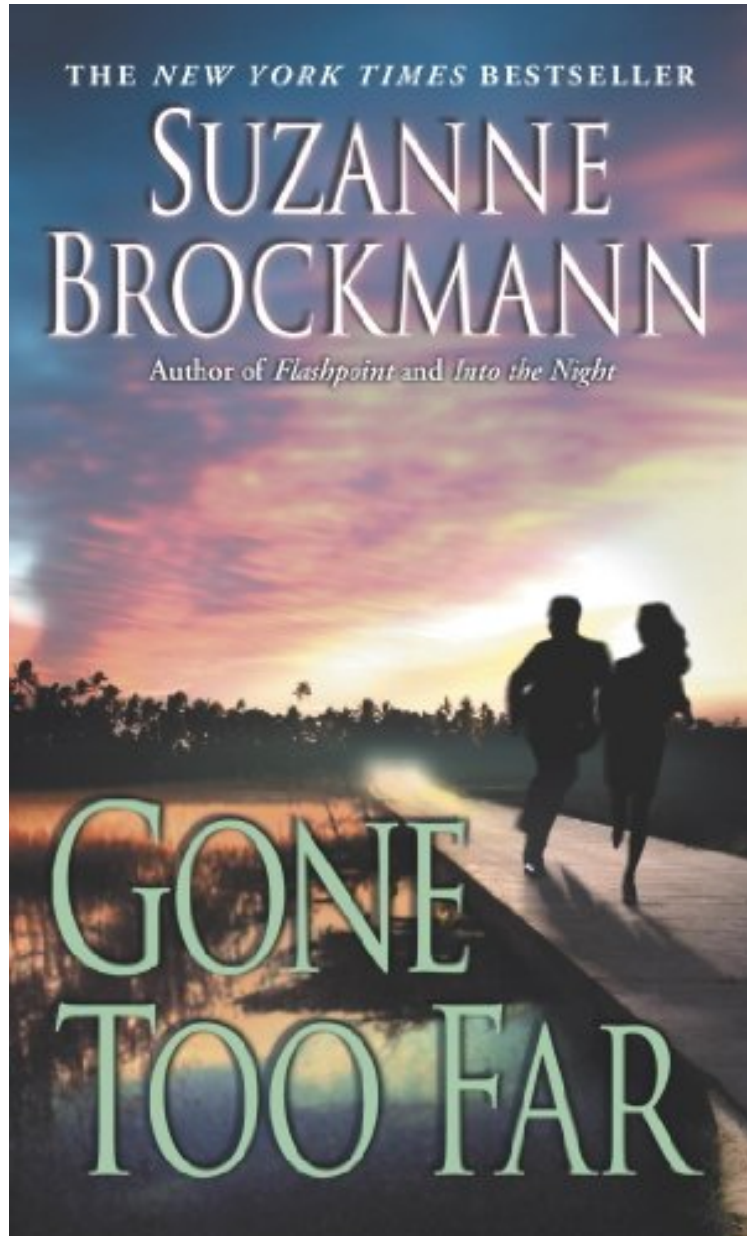

Von ich-lese-gerne zunächst das wichtige: Sam und Alyssa, die Hauptcharaktere in diesem Buch, haben eine gemeinsame Geschichte, die in sich durch die anderen Bücher von Suzanne Brockmann (Unsung hero, Defiant hero, Over the edge, Out of control, Into the night) zieht. Aber auch ohne Vorkenntnisse kann man dieses Buch lesen. Gleich am Anfang beginnt die Aufregung: Nach der Scheidung möchte Sam endlich seine Tochter in Florida besuchen - jedoch findet er ein Haus mit einer Leiche vor und nicht seine Familie. Nun macht er sich auf die Suche nach seiner verschwundenen Ex-Frau. Und wer ist seine einzige Hoffnung und Hilfe? Die FBI-Agentin Alyssa, mit der ihn eine gescheiterte Beziehung verbindet. Haben die beiden noch eine Chance zusammen oder verbindet Alyssa und ihren Boss mehr als nur eine berufliche Beziehung. Wem diese Story nicht viel gibt: Egal, trotzdem lesen. Allein schon die Dialoge zwischen Sam und Alyssa sind den Preis wert. Sie sind rührend, herzergreifend, völlig realistisch und trotzdem humorvoll. First of all, if you haven't read any of Suzanne Brockmanns previous Troubleshooters books, don't pick up this one first. The book does stand on its own and can be read without having read the others in the series first. But that would be quite a shame! So if you contemplate reading this book, take my advice, pick up the first in the series and read all of them in order. Trust me, each and every one of these books will be well worth your time. And when you get to "Gone too far", the book will blow you away, it is that awesome! In Gone too far, Suzanne Brockmann picks up pretty shortly after she left off in the previous book. Mary Lou has left Sam and moved to Florida. When Mary Lou doesn't return the divorce papers, Sam flies out to Sarasota to confront Mary Lou, only to discover, that there is a dead woman in Mary Lou's house. Hayley, their 2 year old daughter is missing. At the same time Lt. Tom Paoletti is taken in custody to be questioned regarding the president's assassination attempt. All of this happened in the previous book. We soon learn, that both stories are somehow connected. The FBI is also investigating the attempt and Sam calls Alyssa for help in finding his daughter. The story is way too complicated to summarize in a few sentences here. And as I mentioned before, if you haven't read the previous books in the series you can't fully enjoy the rich history in this book. We get to meet a lot of "old friends" from previous books. Tom and Kelly are back and they struggle to find their happiness. Sam and Alyssa of course are finally getting their HEA. And to watch this unfold through the course of the books is nailbiting, exciting, romantic, funny and tender all at the same time. Max Baghat is back as well, and we learn he hasn't been able to put Gina (whom he met in Over the edge) out of his mind. He meets Gina in Florida and I thought their story was just as awesome as Sam and Alyssa's. I can't wait to read their story, which is coming up in Breaking point. If you are looking for an awesome read, that you can't put down. Grab all the books in the Troubleshooters series.
