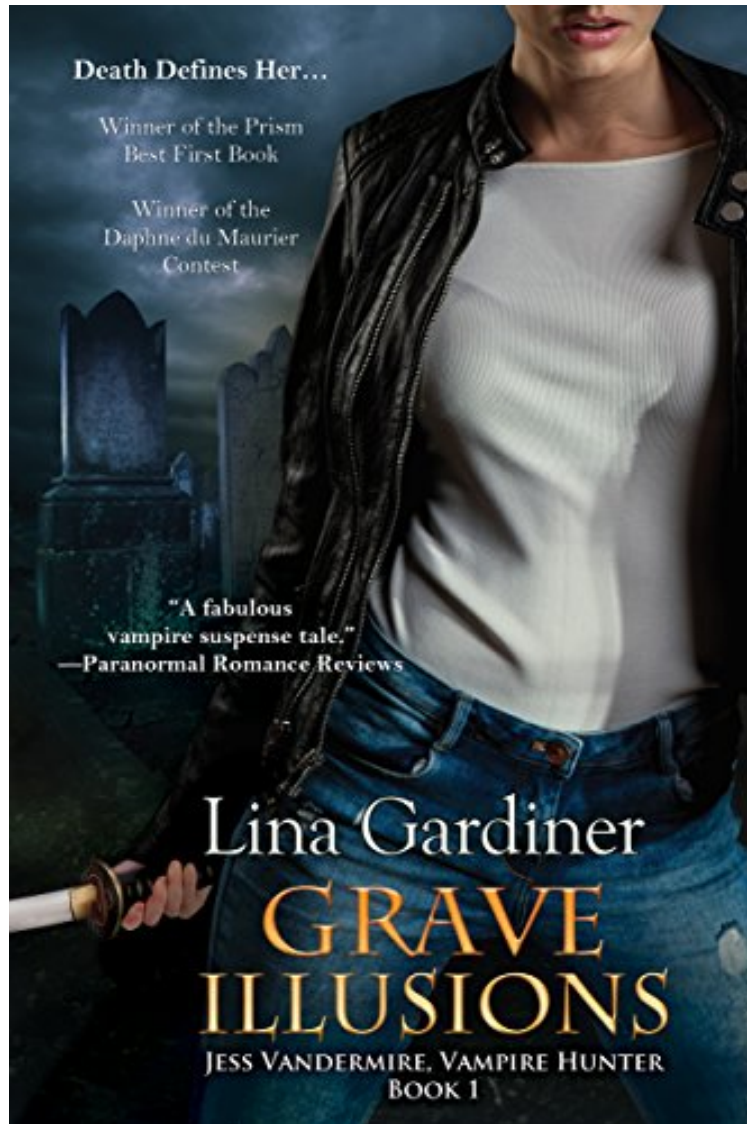

a lot to like about this book, particularly the setting within a special police force which deals with vampires - and is led by one. I found the pacing a bit varied with long sections where not much seemed to happen, then suddenly we'd skipped forward a week or so. The initial scenes between Jess and John were good but later scenes seemed a bit forced. I also found the fight scenes between the baddies and goodies not always convincing. There were a few interesting plot elements, such as John's history coming back to bite him (metaphorically, anyway), but I found the resolution of the book slightly lacking (it's the start of a series, I believe). For a book that didn't cost me anything it was a reasonable read but I think if I'd paid for it I might have been a bit disappointed.
