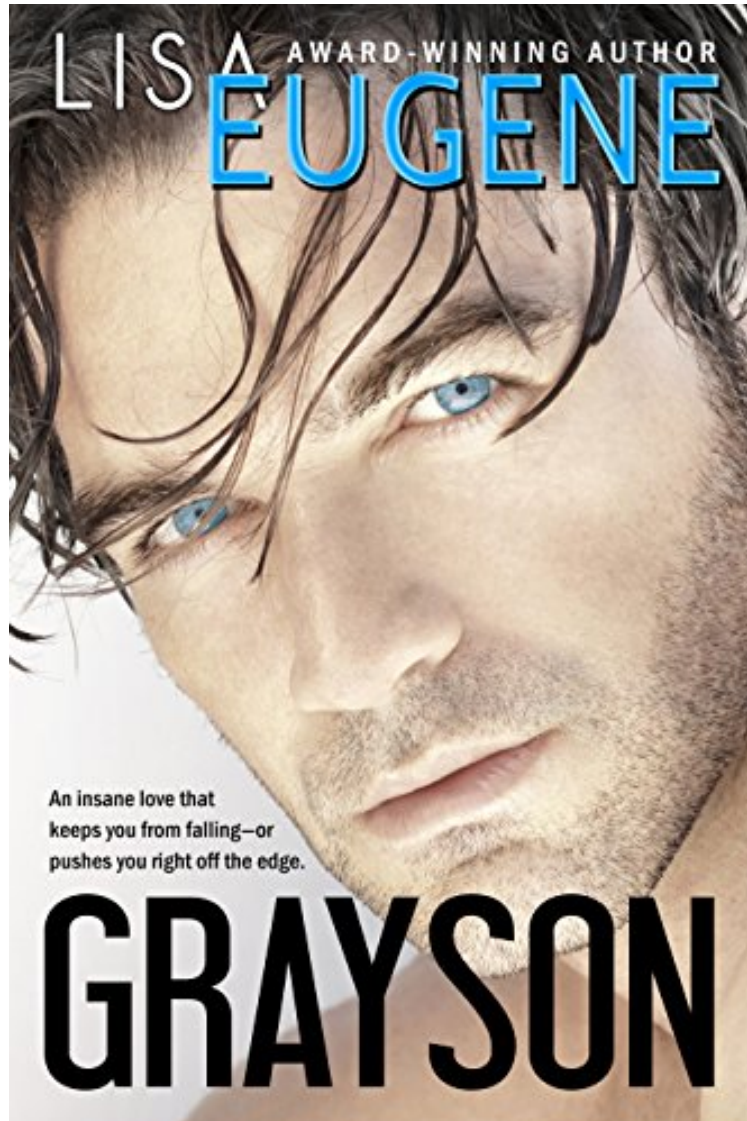

Such a delicate topic, such a complex and intense man, such a wonderful tear-jerking epilogue if all of the above doesn't touch you then I don't know what will. It is the first book by Lisa Eugene I've read but it won't be my last! Angie is a 24 year-old grad student who desperately tries to make ends meet. One job doesn't pay off enough, so she is looking for a second one that does not contain taking her clothes off. She comes across an ad for a house cleaning job and is about to discover that this term is meant literally; but more importantly, she is about to learn about the mysterious man living isolated upstairs a man she has been warned about by her boss. Grayson is the father of her nineteen year-old employer and with that fact Angie assumes that he must be an elderly man. After primarily following the order of never going upstairs, curiosity gets the best of her one day, so she sneaks upstairs only to experience a major surprise regarding the man living there. He has nothing elderly and grouchy on him or even dangerous as his son wanted to make her believe instead, he is a gorgeous middle-aged man oozing hotness, who suffers from paranoid schizophrenia and chooses a secluded life, battling everyday on his own and simply refusing to take his meds. Despite his illness and / or their huge age difference, Angie cannot deny her attraction toward him, so while decluttering his chaotic home, she finds ways to spend more time with him, slowly gaining his trust and building an incredibly beautiful friendship which soon starts to turn into something more. This book seriously is a treasure. The delicate topic as well as the age gap drew me in right away, and Lisa Eugene created an absolute masterpiece out of it! Angie is a strong heroine, a pioneer at that: Breaking off stereotypes by not letting his state of mental health define the man that is Grayson. She sees the human being and treats him as one, providing him the normal life and treatment that he deserves. She never leaves his side, but stands by him during every single breakdown, giving him the strength he needs. Secondly, she doesn't care about his age twenty years her senior, he could have been her father, yet, she doesn't care for what other people might think, she only cares for him. Her one goal: Being let in into his life. She breaks all the rules and confirms the saying: Love knows no boundaries! Grayson Oh, I fell for this man! Battling his mental illness every day, he hides his good-looks and his perceptive, simply beautiful soul. When his own blood turns against him, he loses all his hope and almost gives himself up and again it is Angie, a young woman in her twenties, who comes to save him in more ways than one and who makes his life worth living again.
