weiterempfehlen. Es werden viele Fragen beantwortet, aber auch einige offen gelassen. Zum Beispiel wird nur sehr geringfügig auf das Ende der Forerunner-Zivilisation an sich eingegangen. Tausende Welten die dem Feind zum Opfer fallen sind wenn überhaupt nur Funoten, kleinere Details werden vollkommen außer Acht gelassen (im krassen Gegensatz zu zB The Fall of Reach), hier stehen die Geschehnisse rund um den Iso-Didact und der Librarian im Vordergrund. Im Endeffekt gibt es dem ganzen eine mystische Note, wie die Erzhlung einer Legende, und das macht es für mich nur umso interessanter zu lesen. Und zugegeben, die 330 Seiten Hardcover sind schnell gelesen.
