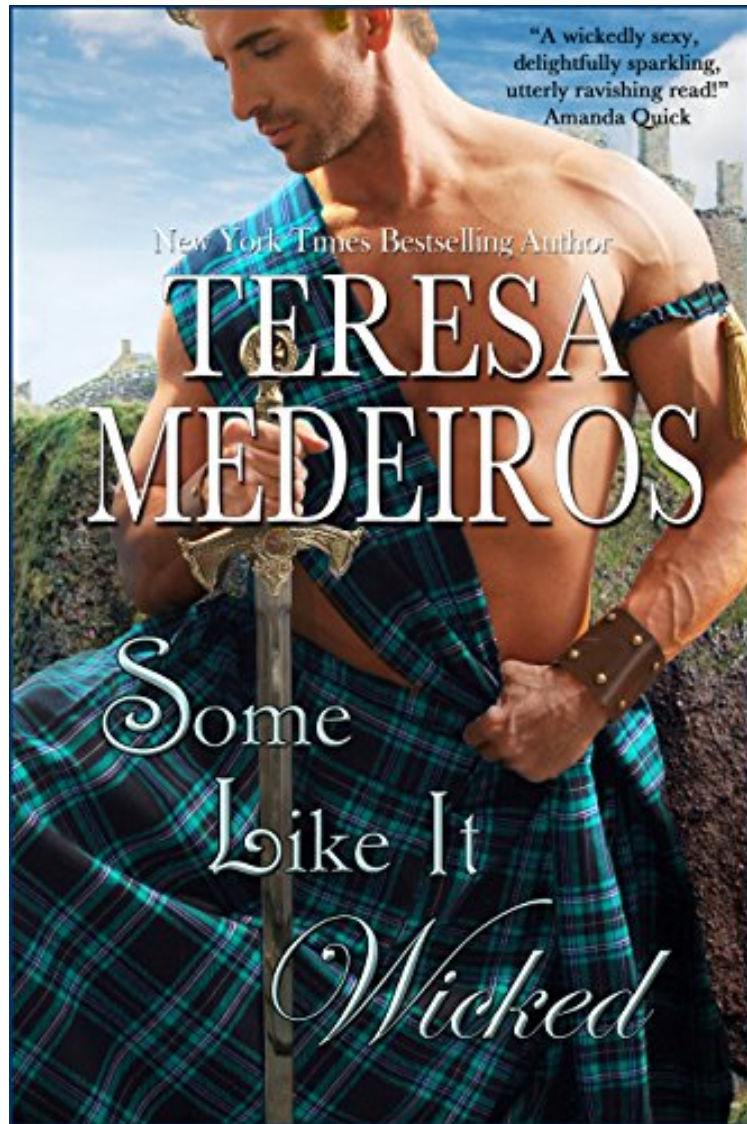

backtrack one and order Catriona's story (Some Like It Wicked). It's like two completely different people wrote these books. Some Like It Wicked started out alright--Catriona's stuck in England with her ancestral lands in Scotland in trouble, and an uncle who thinks marrying her off to the first available guy will protect her. So Catriona decides to find Simon Westcott, a rogue of a man she met while he was trying to seduce her cousin five years before. He's in trouble and she has just enough of a dowry to persuade him into marrying her and take her to Scotland. It's a business arrangement through and through, until Simon decides he doesn't want a platonic marriage. Here's where it went wrong for me. Catriona had the upper hand, and to this point had been set up as an independent, crafty thinker who knows how to stand up for herself. She had no reason to agree. In fact, given what I had read thus far, I expected her to clock him and walk away. He needed her, she barely needed him. However, she meekly agrees (complete with trembling hands). I realize that it furthered the story, but it left a bitter taste in my mouth. I thought she would take it in a very interesting direction, but instead the story fell into a cliché. Which then got worse. Simon actually gets angry she agreed to the bargain! That makes no sense. He's the one that offered, his characterization gives no hint whatsoever that he's into rescuing women from themselves (and in this case, it's actually from him) and he strides over---And that's where I stopped. A story that could have been truly magical actually nosedived by chapter five. It really had so much potential, and in the end I felt let down before the story even really got rolling. I've read a dozen other Teresa Medeiros books, and they're all quite wonderful. I have no idea what happened here, but it's a real shame.

She has vowed to return to Scotland and restore Clan Kincaid's honour but knows she can't do it on her own. However she believes that Sir Simon Westcott, a notorious rogue but also a naval hero, might be able to help her. She manages to persuade him to marry her and take her on a honeymoon to Scotland, telling him that she will then give him half her dowry and they can get an annulment. Unfortunately for Catriona, Simon isn't as malleable as she hopes and events don't go according to plan, especially when she finds that the remaining Kincaid clan members in Scotland aren't exactly what she was hoping for. Can she and Simon make some kind of future together? Can they restore Clan Kincaid's honour? This was a slightly odd book with the characters' actions often rather difficult to understand. The central romance wasn't particularly romantic and it was hard to evaluate what the hero and heroine felt for each other. The hero was rather more of an anti-hero most of the time and the heroine was incredibly nave and silly at the same time. The plotting wasn't particularly deep and there were many events which were frankly too unbelievable to swallow with little actual reflection of behaviour in this period of history. However the story had its moments of freshness and it was a reasonable read overall, if rather disappointing because of the characterisation.
