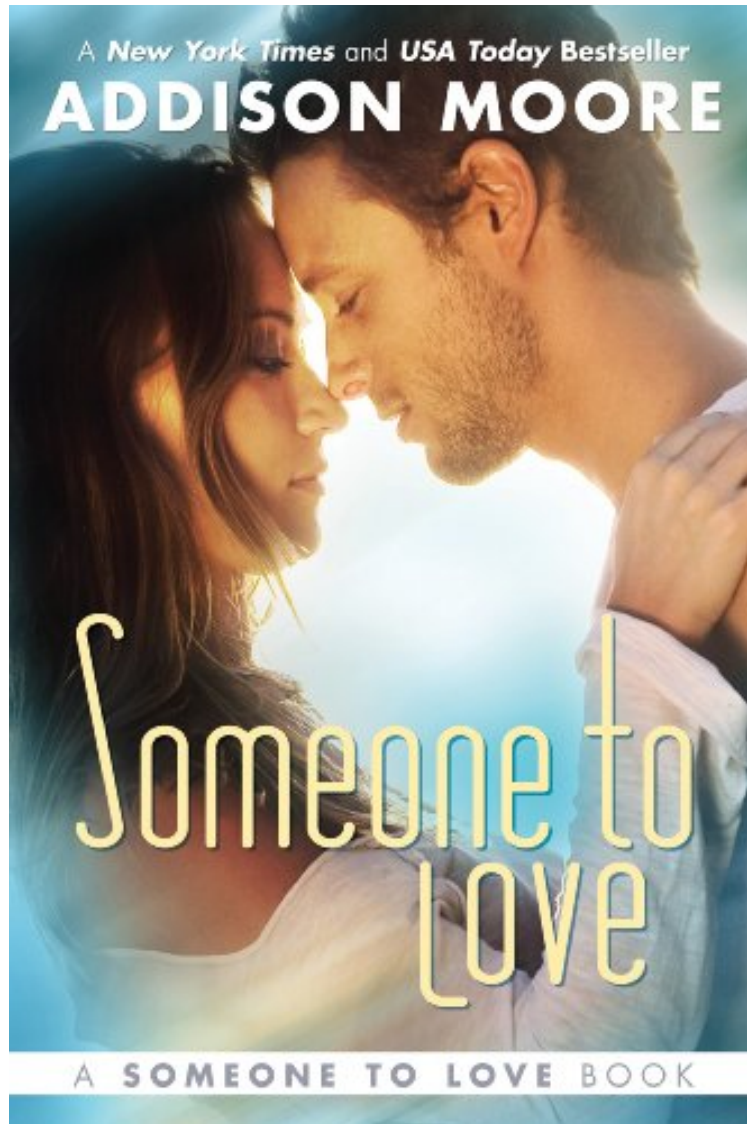

Die Gründe hierfür wurden bereits in Magrittes BTM-Rezension behandelt (auch wenn ich noch welche hinzufügen könnte), daher mache ich es kurz: Ich kann das Buch nicht wirklich empfehlen. Nicht nur, weil ich das Gefühl habe, dass für junge Leute ein absolut fatales Bild von Liebe, Sex und vor allem Verhütung gezeichnet wird (die Beziehung und das Verhalten/Denken der Hauptpersonen, etc. würde ich niemanden guten Gewissens als Vorbild geben), sondern auch, weil ich das Buch immer wieder aus der Hand legen musste, um eine Pause zu bekommen. Ich lese Bücher aus Prinzip immer zu Ende (es könnte ja eine Wendung kommen), aber hier war es ein schwerer Kampf. Wenn ein Buch für euch nicht unbedingt in die reale Welt übertragbar sein muss, dann könnte euch die Geschichte und die Handlung durchaus gefallen. 1 von 1 Kunden fanden die folgende Rezension hilfreich. One of 2 books that I didn't finish reading... Von TesterAs mentioned in the headline, I couldn't convince myself to finish reading this book. I have to say that I consider myself as a not-so-critical person when it comes to books but somehow I didn't like this one at all. At first, I was rather confused about the language since I found it quite hard to understand the first chapter. It was not so much the vocabulary but rather the point she wanted to make which I didn't get. It got better after a while but it took away a lot of enthusiasm when I started reading (but maybe this is because I'm not a native speaker... don't know). But what made me shake my head while reading were the characters' actions and how fast the story was progressing. I got the impression as if the author had a lot of funny-sounding ideas just to let people undress or fall in bed together, but I find none of them realistic. Why would a virgin undress in front of 50 people? How can a girl stay (and move in) at a guy's place when she knows him for about 1 hour? Why would a virgin sleep with a womanizer without a condom? And so on it goes... Sorry, but I cannot recommend this book.

Von Magritte Sometimes I start writing a review by exhaling deeply because I have the impression: this is not going to be easy. This is my personal opinion, no offence intended to anyone who liked this book. Plot: When Kendall Jordan begins at Garrison University she meets Cruise Elton. Cruise has been hurt by the girl he loved for 4 years, when he found her on top of another guy his heart broke and he took his revenge by using girls for pleasure only; when he sets his eyes on the beautiful and innocent Kendall Jordan, his interest in her awakens in a different way than with the other girls. As Kendall does not believe in real love she asks him to tutor her to become a "player" with guys like he is with girls, but soon both start to have feelings for each other.

My opinion, attention SPOILER: The plot was OK even if I did not understand why a virgin would want to become a player or even fake to want to become one and why she is so into him from the beginning if she does not believe in love why she wants only him? I couldn't understand how a teacher pays her students to be nude models for their own peers, how a student who replaces a teacher would be a nude model for his students, next to his student, whom he is living with. Why her mother has no trouble with her living with a guy instead of the dorm she is paying for? Why no one even bothers what happened to her place at the dorm? How she could just go and spend her nights at some unknown guys' place? I couldn't believe how incredibly stupid Kendall could be by taking the pill and not knowing anything about it and even telling herself that Cruise will believe her stupid, but still not doing anything to inform herself, couldn't believe that no one worries a bit more about Molly. What disturbed me the most is the lack of honest and sincere communication between the two of them? What loving couple never talks about anything that worries them? This obviously causes the drama at the end. Let's talk about the drama I felt it was evident, didn't feel the described pain the characters felt and knew it would end fast. Sometimes I found their love just too sweet: "Cruise is born of God's own breath and beauty" "Have I mentioned I'm afraid of heights?" she asks as we climb to the roof. "You make me feel safe". "You make me feel safe." I echo[...]"

Written for a very young public it would have been OK, but for that there is too much sex here in my opinion and a too light view of pregnancy, being expelled from university and responsibility towards younger ones such as Molly, which annoyed me. The story and characters simply lacked maturity. I liked the beginning and was really happy when I finished the book, but mainly because it was finished. Being written from the POV of both main characters one after the other should have allowed a real character development, but I simply couldn't understand them. I have probably been looking for something more mature. If however you like a nice romance between two young people without too much depth or drama you could like this book. Enjoy the read MBTM
