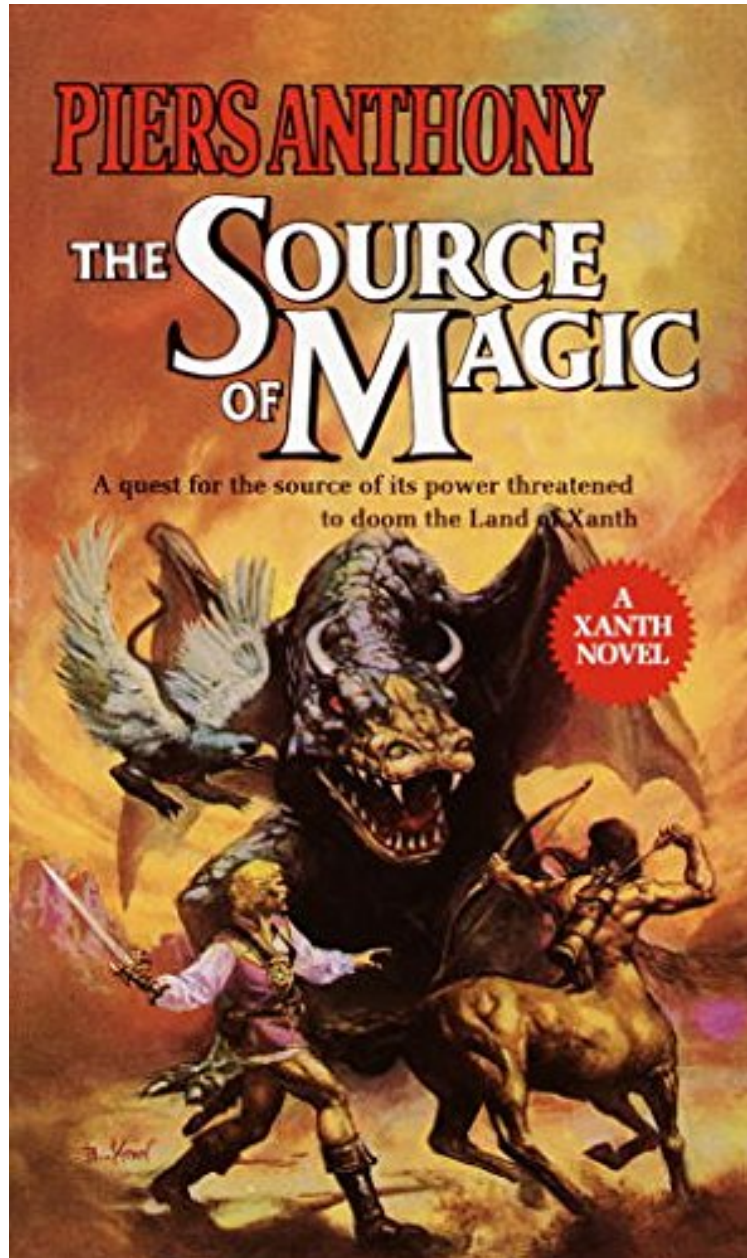

If his style needs a little getting used to, it is worth the effortlessness of enjoyment.
