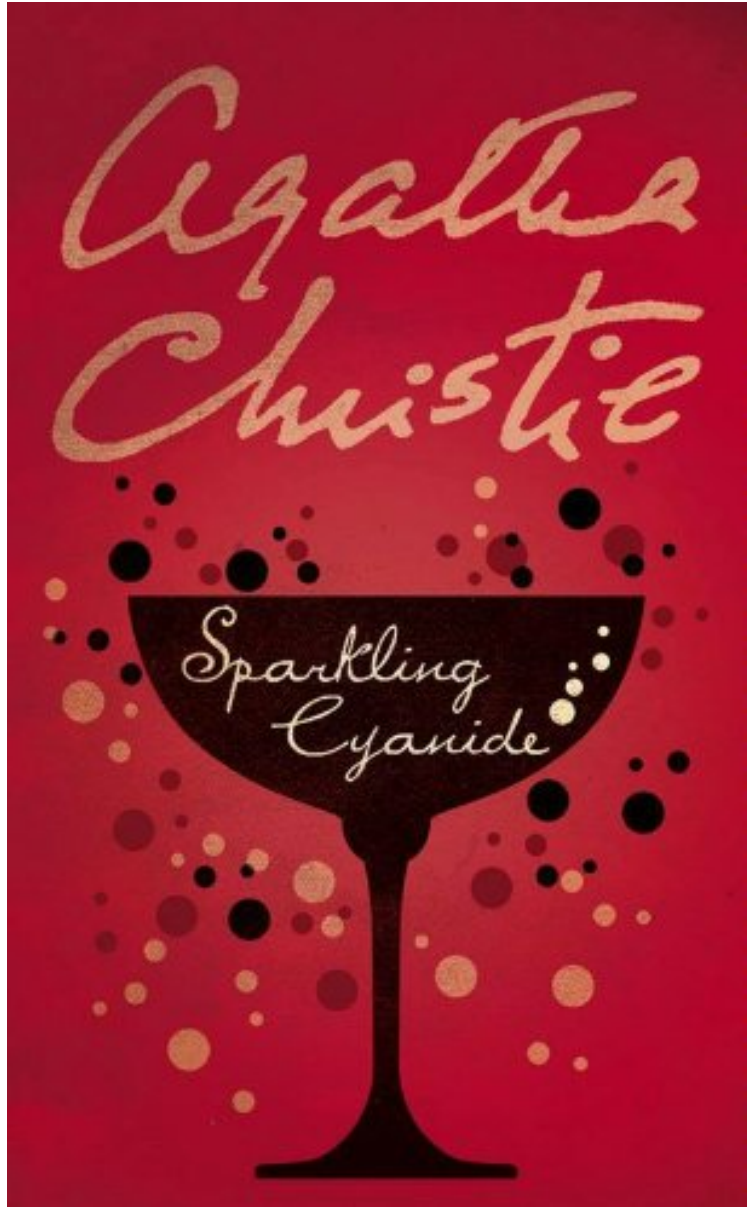

Young Rosemary Barton celebrates her birthday with six friends and relatives: her sister Iris Marle, her husband George Barton, his' secretary Ruth Lessing, Anthony Browne, her lover Stephen Farraday and his wife Alexandra. But during the dinner in a fine club the birthday girl rolls her eyes and falls onto the table. She is dead, obviously died unnaturally. The police finds cyanide in Rosemary's handbag and realize that she had the flu and supposed depressions, so their judgement is suicide. A year later. George Barton has received mysterious letters that tell him his wife hasn't had kill herself, but she died on foreign guilt. So the husband plans to reconstruct the evening of the crime so that he would get to be informed how the murder has had been committed and - what matters most ! - who the murderer is. The solution is, usually with Agatha Christie, completely logical, probably and also surprising. Fun with poison, Christie style... Von Scott E Amundsen Christie's novels where poison is the murder weapon are the most fun. Christie, who worked in a dispensary during World War I, had a certain amount of technical knowledge of various poisons; thus her fondness for it as a weapon in her books. Poison can be used by anyone; it is therefore the perfect weapon for Christie. This one is a particularly jolly romp complete with illicit affairs and mistaken identities. Light in tone, this is not one of her more serious books, but it is extremely clever and, as always, entertaining.
