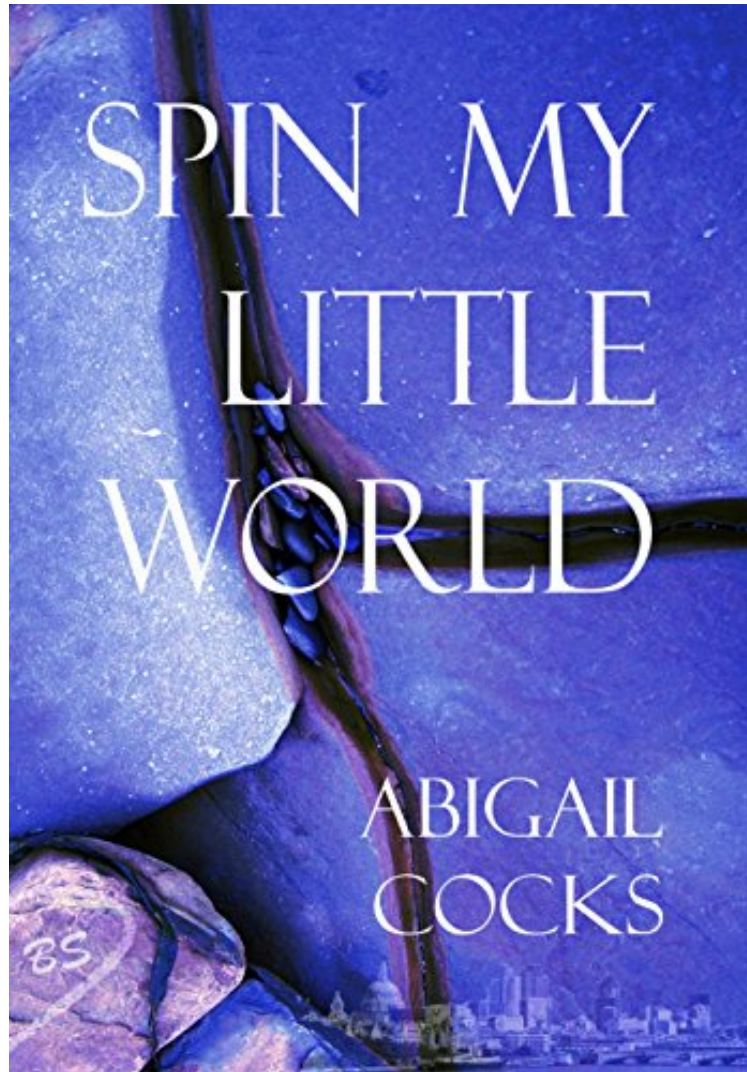

For my sins, I have worked in the ad industry for many years

and I can safely say this is no exaggerated caricature. I think I know Bo Simpson, and many of the other colourful characters in her 'little world.' As a short aside, if you enjoyed Bo's antics, then do read Matt Beaumont's series of 'e' books - the humour and setting is not dissimilar. But what raises the book above being an entertaining, edgy and well-observed 21st century romantic comedy is its depth. The terrible realisation and connection between Bo's potential new boyfriend and a devastating incident in her past is expertly handled such that the reader feels every moment of elation, every pang of guilt, every stab of hurt. My only small gripe is that I'm not a fan of present tense writing. I don't mind it in short stories but I have been known to give up on novels written in the present tense - or even not buy them in the first place. But. I can see that present tense sort of suits the first person narrative and style, so I can nearly, nearly forgive the author on this occasion ;) 'Spin my little world' may technically fall into the category of ChickLit, but fluffy it's not. This chick has teeth, claws and balls - and knows how to use them! P.S. There's a tantalising glimpse of the sequel at the back of the Kindle version, told from the delectable Danny's point of view.
