entwickelt, was sich auch in der Länge der einzelnen Bände niederschlägt. Sowohl die Beziehung zwischen Vic und Jacob, als auch generell die Charaktere, haben alle an Tiefe gewonnen und sich weiterentwickelt. Am deutlichsten zeigt sich diese Veränderung in Vic, der - je mehr er über sein Talent herausfindet und je besser er es zu kontrollieren lernt - immer stärker unter Druck gerät, das wahre Ausmaß seiner Fähigkeiten vor dem omnipresenten FPMP zu verbergen, da er immer noch nicht weiß, was dieses eigentlich im Schilde führt. Der Umstand, dass Jacob selbst nun für das FPMP arbeitet - wenn auch bloß, um Vic so besser vor dessen undurchsichtigen Machenschaften schützen zu können - macht die Sache nicht einfacher. Auch die Handlung ist vielschichtiger geworden, was sich bereits seit dem fünften Band "Camp Hell" abgezeichnet hatte, wobei der rote Faden rund um das FPMP und das Geheimnis, das die Organisation umgibt, sehr schnell verschachtelt und durchwegs spannend ist. Insgesamt kann man den vorliegenden siebten Band durchaus als Wendepunkt und (Zwischen-)Stopp betrachten, an dem man die Geschichte entweder aufhören oder grundstzlich neu ansetzen könnte, wobei ich persönlich auf eine Fortsetzung im gänzlich neuen Stil hoffe.
