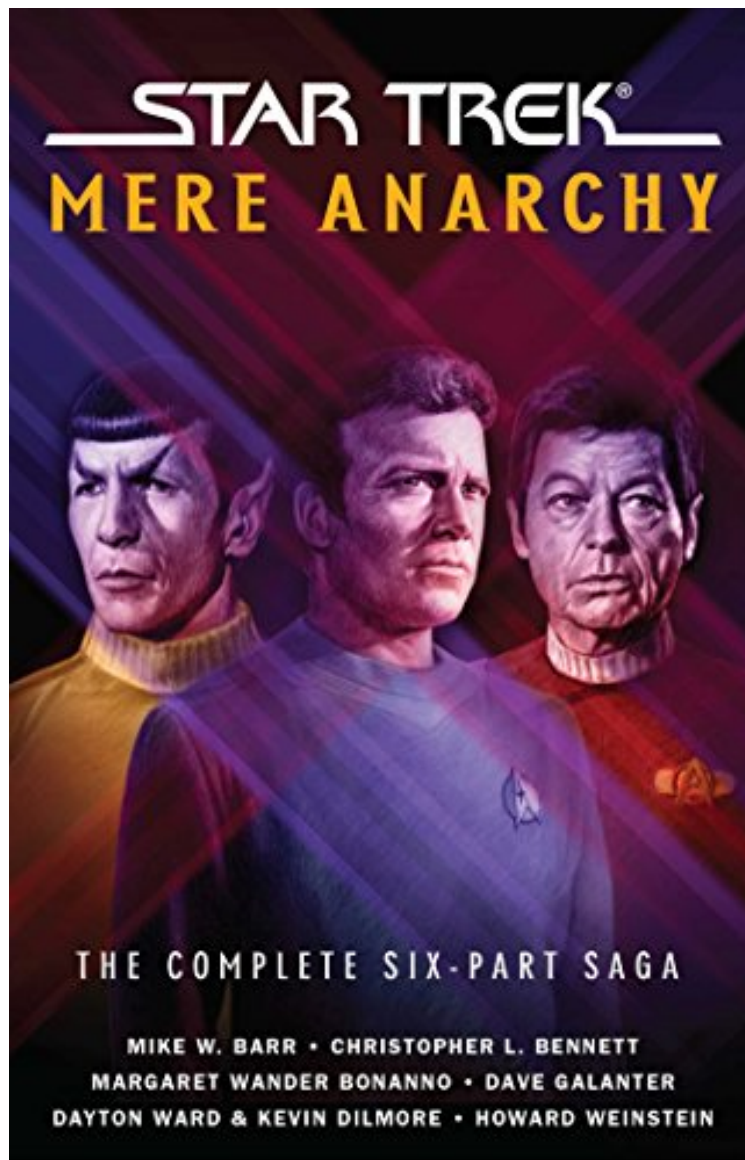

A Good Story-Line shouldn't start as an e-bookVon KundenrezensionenFor the celebration of the 40th anniversary of the first airing of the first ST-episode on TV a lot of quite silent marketing had been going on. If you were a fan you learned about it and the rest of the world didn't really know. One part of the marketing had been this e-book-hexalogy about a planet that Cpt. Kirk sees first very early in his career when he tries to save it from catastrophe, which only in part is successful and six later visits of the crew of the ENTERPRISEs over the decades while the population tries to reverse its misfortune and to find a new way of life in a big community of space-faring species. A lot of current events and political and ideological discussions find in a metaphorical way their path into these stories that the authors wrote in strong collaboration. Each of the story is fine and thought-provoking, but the serial aspect of the e-book-format does lead to quite a lot of content-repetition when read as a collection. Perhaps a "stratifying" of this edition to make it into one big novel - or simply by cutting a few of the redundancies - would have been better. Or readers read it one story per month so they have a chance to forget some things and a glad to be reminded in the next sitting. :-)
