Die zentralen Figuren sind Sheppard und McKay; im Hintergrund findet man u. a. den irritierenden Dr. Kavanagh. Es gibt zwar Anspielungen auf bestimmte Episoden der Fernsehserie, doch was sehr wichtig ist - sie sind meines Erachtens auch dann nicht störend wenn jemand die jeweilige Folge nicht gesehen hat. Ausserdem wird dann beispielsweise nicht nur ein Name genannt, sondern auch in ein-zwei Sätzen erklärt wer das war. Die Kürze der Erklärung hat wiederum den Vorteil, dass jemand, der die Folge gesehen hat und Bescheid weiß im Lesefluss nicht gestört wird.
