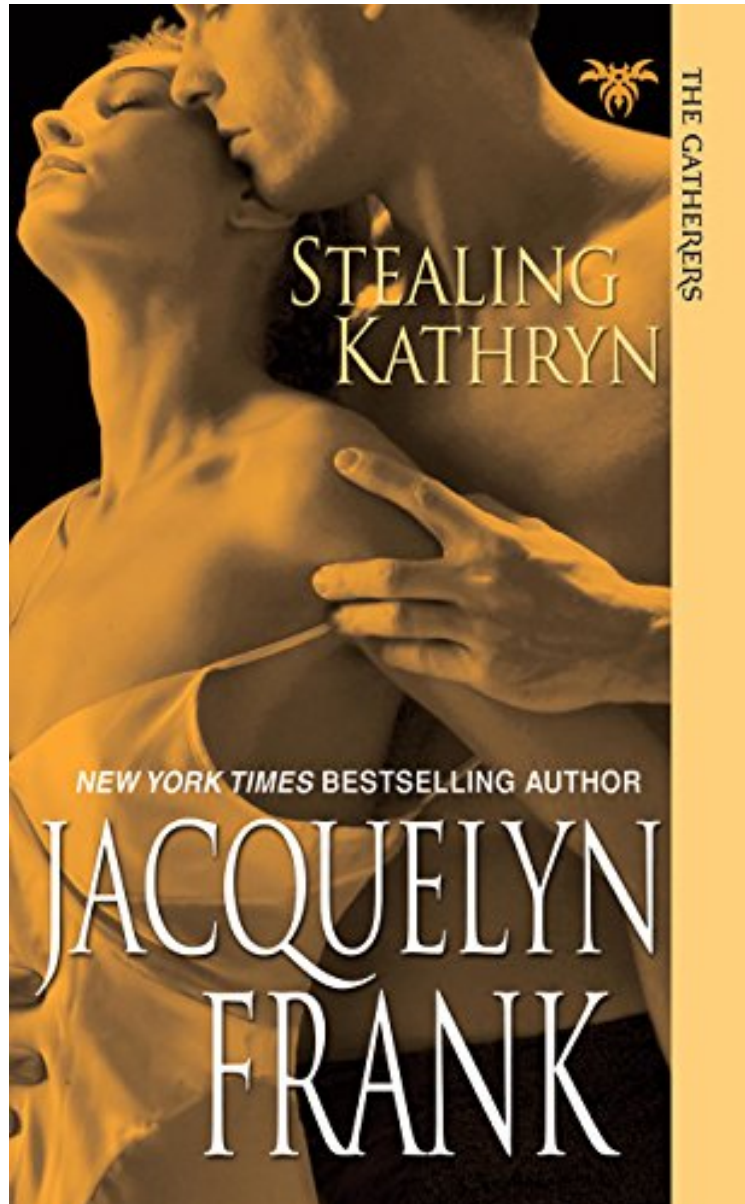

because when we meet the evil and twisted character at the beginning, one who is about to kidnap a woman after giving her terrifying nightmares, we have no idea that he will eventually be the hero. Which he is. And a surprisingly heroic one. Mind you, the heroine, Kathryn, is fairly unusual too in that she seems able to cope with pretty much everything that's thrown at her - and her life does change rather significantly during the course of the book. The setting is in a world between the human realm and 'The Beneath', and our hero Adrian's job is to gather energy from nightmares to feed his people. Unfortunately this is corrupting work and he's turned into a monster. It's only when he kidnaps Kathryn, to add her to his 'treasures', that he begins to change back into the person he was before. I very much liked the characterisation and descriptiveness of Jacquelyn Frank's writing in this book. There was lots of interaction between the main characters and they were both believable.
