The may contain many of the known elements of other storys -the strong dominating male/ceothe submissive femalethe fact that at least one of them has binding issuesthe running away / breakup thingthe strange/crazy boss/ ex-boyfriend/ex-girlfriend/ex-wife factorsBut it became different in the moment when the relationship between Stuart and Lily hit the bottom of what Stuart actually wants and what he is willing to do to get it.At the beginning I thought this is too much how could he actually expect that from her ??But reading further and further the story made it really believable . I could relate to what he was thinking and how Lily was feeling about it.
