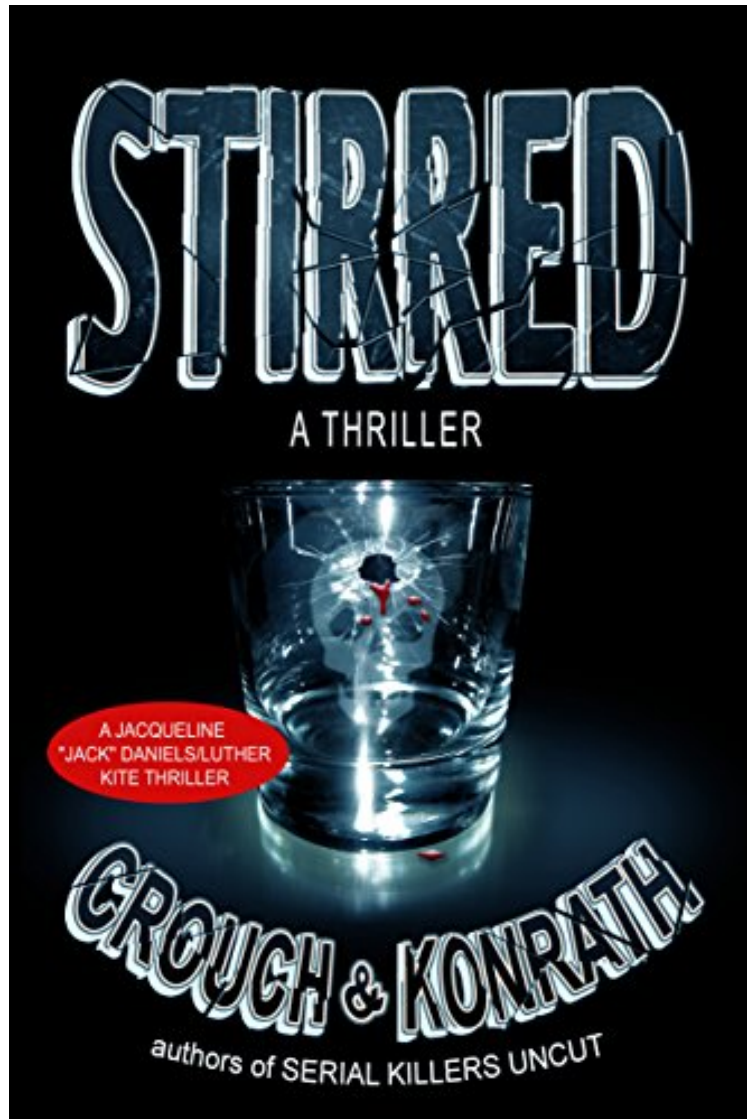

The way both authors have resolved this puzzle - compliments! I have read the book in one night. I simply couldn't stop. I have read all the Jack-Daniels/Luther-Kite books, but this thriller can be read without any knowledge of the universe the authors have created in all the years. Dies sind immer wieder kleine Hinweise für Jack, denn sie ist das wahre Ziel von Luther Kite. Das Buch entwickelt sich recht rasant zu einem Splatter - möchte ich fast sagen -. Denn Kite hinterlässt eine Mörder-Spur um Jack Daniels immer weiter an sich heranzuführen. Er will sie brechen, um mit ihr anschließend mordend durch die Lande zu ziehen. Auf der anderen Seite ist Jack Daniels - wie gesagt eine ehemalige Polizistin -. Kalttherzig, kaltschnuzig, egoistisch und zu stolz, um mal was Vernünftiges zu sagen. Sie steht Luther Kite gegenüber - hochschwanger aber taff wie kein Kerl -. Sie wird von Kite an ihre menschlichen Grenzen gebracht... aber nicht nur sie.
