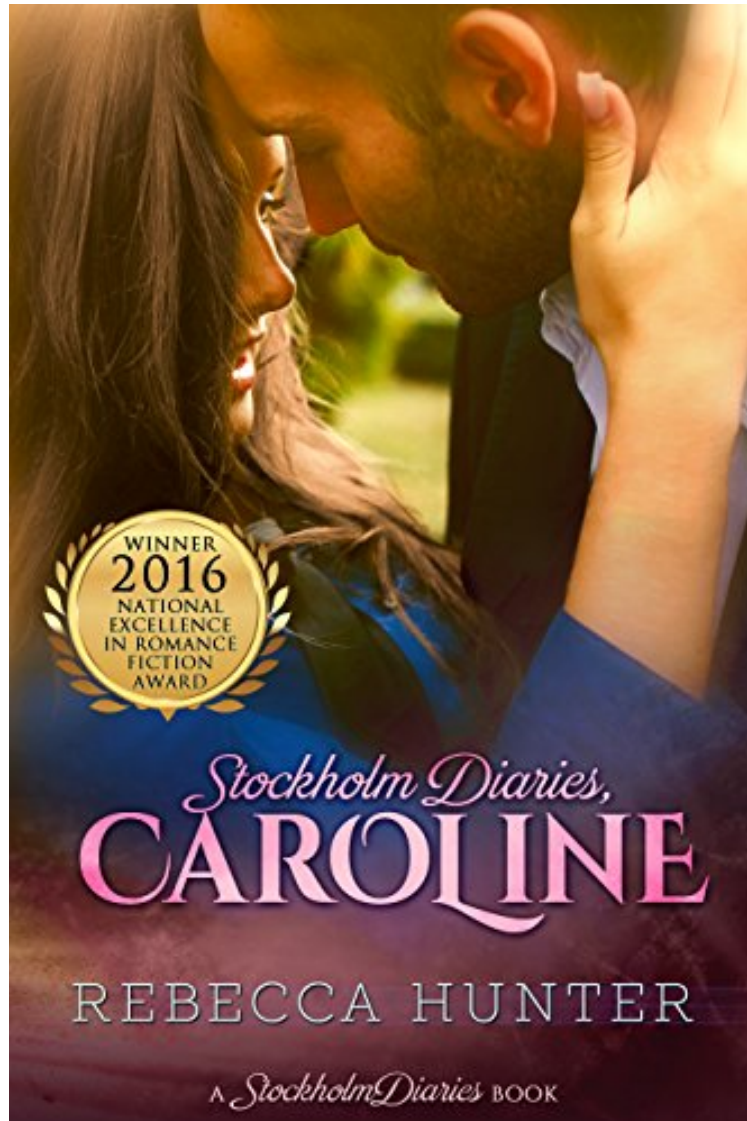

But my biggest regret is that I didn't connect with the story and the characters. It is caused by the writing style and mainly by Caroline's character. She is a thinker and agonizes too much about everything. She analyses everything and doesn't talk much about her feelings. But I need to feel what a character feels to connect with the story and the character. I missed that. And one scene particular annoyed me immensely. I don't want to spoil too much about the story but I think Caroline totally overreacted in a fight with Niklas. Her reaction let me groan and literally roll my eyes.
