Von Catalus I love Ms Kenyons books, yet I have to admit that I don't love every book by her equally. I think this one is among my favorites. It's been a while since I've read a book that I couldn't put down again before I finished, but despite it's length this one held me captive. That said, this book might not be the best start into the dark-hunter series. I guess it's possible to read it on it's own, but there is so very much content in this book, that I am afraid it might confuse new readers. I would recommend reading (at least) Archeron before reading this book, but preferably Night Embrace, Kiss of the Night, Devil May Cry and The Guardian too. Those who have read Ms Kenyons dark-hunter books know Archeron and should at least be familiar with the name of his hated twin Styxx. While the book Styxx holds more than enough completely new material to fill a book of its own, this book is in its own way a twin - The twin to the book Archeron, and like the brothers the books are both similar and yet completely different. Expect to revisit a lot of events that we thought we knew everything about and be prepared to have the ground snatched away from you (something we should be used by now but probably still aren't) when you see them through Styxx eyes in the context of his life. And yet for all it's shock value the book doesn't destroy Archeron's story but enriches it. If Archeron left you wondering about some things, you'll likely find the answers here and if not, you'll probably kick yourself for not having wondered. And once you've turned the last page you'll be both satisfied and wonder if you know the truth now or if there might be a third side to this story. I liked Beth, Styxx Heroine a lot (more than Archeron's Tory, truth to tell) and (unlike Tory in Archeron) we don't have to wait for half the book before she appears. I wasn't disappointed by the romantic aspect because I could feel their love and commitment to each other, but I wouldn't say the focus was on their relationship. It was an important part of the story, but there is a reason this book is named Styxx and not Styxx and Beth. It is his story. If there was one thing I would have changed I would have liked to hear a bit more about her, but hopefully we'll meet her again in future books
